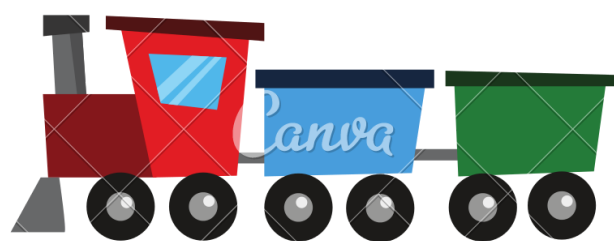


HOW TO DETRACK YOUR DISTRICT TO CLOSE YOUR OPPORTUNITY GAP



A movement to propel student learning through desegregation

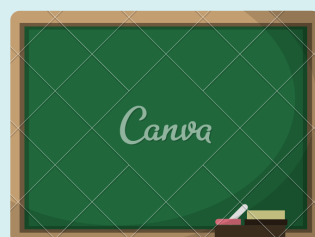
ENGAGE IN A THOUGHTFUL STUDY

Collecting and comparing data one class at a time allows for a thoughtful integration process and supports the effectiveness of the program



START AT THE BEGINNING

Start with one class that begins tracking in your district and build high level, attainable curriculum as well as a versatile master schedule to support for all students.



WORK WITH INTERESTED TEACHERS

This permits minimal push-back and massive capacity for change. Once these teachers have success, other teachers will be more likely adopt these practices in their own classrooms



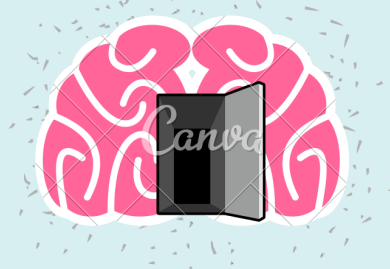
ELIMINATE LOWEST FIRST

Low-track, deficit-mindset focused classes must be the first to be eliminated. Creating high-level, differentiated instruction for all creates an inclusive environment for student learning to happen



OPEN GATES THROUGH CHOICE

Designate the highest level course as the default enrollment, but let students and parents "opt-out." This asset-based approach will encourage students to try the course, and make the transition to a fully detracked course load easier
